The Purpose

Aboriginal Leadership in Cricket

By offering the Aboriginal Leadership in Cricket scholarship, SEDA College WA aims to empower young Aboriginal individuals with a passion for cricket to cultivate essential skills that support their educational and career goals, while fostering leadership qualities and promoting cultural awareness.

The Scholarship

Scholarship recipients will receive:

> **Scholarship Value**: up to \$5,000 per year of the Cricket Australia Sports Development Program student fees in Year 11 and Year 12.

The Criteria

Applicants must meet the below scholarship criteria:

- > Apply and be eligible to enrol to at SEDA College WA at the commencement of Year 11 of the applicant.
- > Be enrolled in the Cricket Australia Sports Development Program.
- > Be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent and be able to provide proof of descent.

The Application

- > Provide a video, maximum of five minutes, addressing:
 - Reflecting on your involvement in cricket, how has it helped to shape you as an Aboriginal leader. What specific leadership qualities or skills have you developed through the sport, and how have these contributed to your personal growth and development?
 - Describe how your participation in cricket has enabled you to make a positive impact within your community. Please include specific examples of initiatives, activities or roles you have taken on that illustrate this impact.
 - In your own words, what are the main challenges and opportunities for increasing Aboriginal representation and leadership in cricket? How can we overcome these challenges, and what ideas do you have for making sure Aboriginal players and leaders feel included and supported in the sport?
- > Complete and submit the Scholarship application form.
